NEWS IN BRIEF

Ganga water supply to be started soon in GreNo West

Noida
Ganga water supply will begin in Greater Noida West by the end of this month. Survey work for the main pipeline has been expedited. Leakage problems found at three locations are being resolved.

After this, Ganga water supply will begin. Initially, 40-50 percent Ganga water will be supplied along with groundwater. In fact, to save groundwater, the authority is trying to provide pure drinking water through the Ganga water supply scheme in the urban and rural areas of Greater Noida.

Ganga water is being supplied to most sectors in Greater Noida East including Alpha, Beta, Gamma, Delta, Sigma, and Svam Nagar. Currently, water is being supplied to households by mixing it with groundwater. Ganga water will reach the remaining sectors within a week.

According to the officials concerned, work on the Ganga water supply plan for Greater Noida West sectors has been accelerated. Senior manager Vinod Sharma stated that Ganga water has reached Char Murti/Gaur Chokh. Survey work is underway for the main pipeline. Leakage problems have been identified at three locations in the main pipeline, which are being addressed.

The Ganga water supply is expected to begin in Greater Noida West next week. Currently, approximately 270 MLD of drinking water is being supplied to Greater Noida East and West combined, which includes a partial 60-70 MLD of Ganga water. The amount of Ganga water will be increased in the future. The authority plans to supply 100% Ganga water in the future.

NDMC's renovated escalators dedicated to public

NDMC chairman Keshav Chandra and vice-chairman Kuljeet Singh Chahal here on Friday inaugurated the renovated escalators at the Foot Over Bridge near Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia (RML) Hospital and Mother Teresa Crescent Road. On the occasion, NDMC chairman Chandra stated that these escalators and foot over bridges were constructed during the Commonwealth Games, but they had remained out of service for some time due to technical problems. The escalators near RML Hospital and Mother Teresa Crescent Road have now been restored.

He further informed that to avoid any future inconvenience, the NDMC had decided to hand over the maintenance and security of these escalators to an external agency. The foot over bridge provides a safe alternative for crossing the busy road near the hospital.

Chahal, on this occasion, said that the foot over bridges and escalators near RML Hospital and Mother Teresa Crescent Road would greatly benefit patients, senior citizens, their attendants and other visitors. He informed that all escalators in the NDMC area were now being kept operational and special staff had been deployed for their maintenance. Security guards had also been appointed to prevent theft of escalator parts and components.

Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday launched the 'Khe-Lo Delhi-Delhi Khel Mahakumbh' at Chhatrasal Stadium, marking a historic moment for Delhi as it hosts its first state-level sports festival, aiming to engage over 30,000 athletes.

The inauguration ceremony at Chhatrasal Stadium featured a grand march-past by athletes and performers led by Delhi's para-athletes while Chief Minister Gupta and cricketer Shikhar Dhawan, who is the Brand Ambassador of the event, took a round of the stadium in an open SUV.

Young musicians and artists in Delhi brought festive cheer with their performance, entertaining thousands of youth at the stadium.

This month-long event spans 17 stadiums, including well-known venues in the city, and is seen as a pivotal step in making sports a key aspect of Delhi's development.



She stated that the right platform was previously lacking and highlighted the importance of this festival in providing direction and opportunity for young athletes. Gupta announced substantial prize money for athletes, releasing nearly ₹33 crore that had been held up for years. Under the new sports policy, gold medalists in major events will receive ₹7 crore, while silver and bronze medalists will be awarded ₹5 crore and ₹3 crore, respectively. Athletes at national and international levels can qualify for annual assistance of ₹20 lakh, and school students will get up to ₹5 lakh along with life insurance coverage.

The Chief Minister reaffirmed the government's dedication to enhancing Delhi's sports infrastructure, planning new stadiums and better facilities for athletes. She expressed a goal that no athlete should lack resources while competing. Minister Ashish Sood lauded the Delhi Khel Mahakumbh as a people's movement to establish Delhi as the sports capital of India, highlighting the importance of a strong sports culture for the city's growth.

He conveyed that local gyms and community stadiums would become training grounds for future champions, aiming for a confident and capable approach towards sports in Delhi. The festival lasts a month at major venues and also serves as a platform to upgrade the city's sports infrastructure. Competitions are set in seven core sports: athletics, football, wrestling, basketball, volleyball, badminton, and squash, with participants from schools, colleges, and local clubs. Over 16,000 athletes have already registered, looking toward a goal of 30,000 participants, and eventually targeting one lakh grassroots athletes each year. Special attention is given to encouraging women's participation in sports, with measures in place to ensure their safety and comfort. This initiative aims to empower young women in sports, promoting social change through their involvement.

Chief Minister Rekha Gupta on Friday inaugurated 51 new Ayushman Arogya Mandirs from Fatehpur Beri in Sonapat, Delhi, taking the total number of such centres in the capital to 370 within just eight months. The rapid expansion marks a significant push towards strengthening primary healthcare infrastructure across Delhi.

Describing the centres as more than treatment facilities, the Chief Minister said they are "spaces of trust, prevention and service" designed to bring affordable and accessible healthcare to every neighbourhood. Each Ayushman Arogya Mandir offers nearly 80 types of free diagnostic tests, essential medicines, cancer screening, immunisation services, maternal and child healthcare, elderly care and screening for non-communicable diseases. Equipped with modern infrastructure, the centres aim to reduce the burden on major hospitals and cut long waiting times.

During her visit, the Chief Minister inspected the facilities and reviewed the availability of medicines, diagnostic services and patient care systems. She reiterated that healthcare is an investment in human capital and announced that the government plans to establish over 1,100 Ayushman Arogya Mandirs in the coming years.

On the occasion, development projects worth ₹322 crore were also launched in the Chhatrapati Assembly constituency. The projects include road construction and strengthening, drainage improvements, traffic de-

Tight security arrangements made for board exams in Noida

The Gautam Buddha Nagar district administration claims to have made necessary arrangements to conduct the Uttar Pradesh Board examinations which will be held from February 18 to March 12. There are 60 examination centres for the said board examinations, said the officials concerned. They were of the view that the examinations would be conducted in a completely fair, transparent, peaceful manner and devoid of any cheating. Woman survives fall from Hotel; argument with companion under probe

Panic gripped the Fars Bazar area of the national capital on Friday afternoon after a 20-year-old woman allegedly attempted suicide by jumping from the fourth floor of a hotel on 60 Feet Road.

According to Prashant Gautam, Deputy Commissioner of Police, information was received around 1 pm that a young woman had jumped from Hotel Santosh Residency. Police teams from the Fars Bazar police station and a PCR unit rushed to the spot immediately.

During preliminary investigation, police found that the woman, a resident of Sunar Nagar, had checked into the hotel along with a 22-year-old man from Bulandshahr in Uttar Pradesh. Officials said an argument reportedly broke out between the two inside the hotel room. In the heat of the moment, the woman allegedly climbed to the fourth-floor window and jumped.

An eyewitness present at the scene said he noticed the woman sitting on the window and sensed that she might take an extreme step. Acting swiftly, he gathered empty cardboard cartons lying by the roadside and spread them directly below the window where she appeared likely to fall. Moments later, when she jumped, she landed on the pile of cartons. The cartons cushioned the impact, significantly reducing the force of the fall and preventing serious injuries.

Police said the woman was immediately taken to a nearby hospital, where she is undergoing treatment. Doctors have reported that she is out of danger.

The man who had checked into the hotel with her has been taken into custody and is being questioned. Investigators are examining CCTV footage from the hotel premises to ascertain the sequence of events and determine whether the woman jumped on her own or was provoked in any manner.
